1. Bagging or boxing all of your items in disposable, non-returnable containers
2. Assessing the value of your items for tax purposes (if appropriate) prior to dropping off your donation
3. Calling 803-798-3341 to make volunteers aware of your arrival
4. Transporting your items into the designated drop-off area (hand truck provided)
